# Introduction

## **The Land of Freedom**

Americans can tell you that we live in a free country. Many apparently believe that our freedom can never be taken away.

## **Repression Elsewhere**

The people of North Korea are among the least free and most repressed in the world.<sup>i</sup> They are poor, and many are hungry.<sup>ii</sup> Millions have died in famines, but propaganda and suppression of info make many believe they are better off than everyone else.

When the people of Communist China occupied Tiananmen Square for freedom of speech and the press, they were forcibly removed. Many were killed and thousands more were injured.

Rights to freedom of speech, the press, religion, self-defense, and many other rights are suppressed to maintain control under communist and socialist regimes, and under many theocracies.

## **Repression and Propaganda in the Land of Freedom**

In America, our freedom of speech and the press have been gradually diminished, while we have been conditioned to ignore the loss of our freedom and other rights.

Mass media drowns out serious discussion of issues under a flood of propaganda and misinformation, and suppresses much information that disagrees with government leaders.

Most political speech has been reduced to personal insults and trash talk, and we have been conditioned to regard valid criticism of government policies as just bickering over details.

Many Americans are now repulsed by attempts to seriously discuss our freedom and the protection of our rights.

Few notice the dominant political party's use of government force to punish political dissent, even as they now prepare to file criminal charges against people who disagree with them. <sup>iii</sup>

Our government doesn't censor our news or directly control its content yet, because the dominant party controls it indirectly.

They have persuaded many good people to support their policies and programs with good intentions, while they actually divide us to destroy our freedom and protection of our rights.

My purpose is not to offend the people who have supported them with good intentions, but we must overcome our reluctance to discuss our rights and freedom now, or we will live like the people of China and North Korea, who only wish they could.

## **American Freedom vs. Subjugation**

### **The Land of Freedom and Prosperity**

Americans live in a land of freedom, security, peace, and prosperity today because the United States was founded on the principle that all people possess natural rights granted by God, and because of the limited government our founders designed and built to protect our freedom.

### **The Rewards of Freedom**

The “Blessings of Liberty,” as our founders called them,<sup>iv</sup> are made possible by the protection of our natural rights.

Inventions have flowed from the US. American light bulbs, telephones, automobiles, TVs, airplanes, computers, and internet have improved the standard of living here and around the world.

Freedom has made us prosperous. Even poor Americans generally have clean drinking water, food, clothing, and live in heated buildings. Many have cars, cell phones, and cable TV.

Education is available to all, although some of it is not of good quality. We have free access to computers, newspapers and books at public libraries, and any American can improve his or her condition in life through hard work and education.

There are no permanent classes here. Free enterprise, also called capitalism, has enabled millions of Americans to become successful and wealthy through their own skills and labor.

We live in a country where Michael Jordan could become a champion professional basketball player, a multi-millionaire businessman, and owner of a professional basketball team.

It’s where Clarence Thomas, whose ancestors were slaves, could become one of our country’s most important defenders of freedom as a Justice of the United States Supreme Court.

It's where Bill Gates could turn his passion for computers into a huge corporation and a multi-billion dollar fortune.

It's a country where Condoleezza Rice could overcome racial violence in which her friend and three other girls were murdered by Ku Klux Klan (KKK) terrorists (the enforcement arm of the Democratic Party) , to become a college professor, provost, National Security Advisor, and US Secretary of State.

It's where Ben Carson could use his intelligence and skills to become a renowned brain surgeon and Director of Pediatric Neurosurgery at a leading research and teaching hospital.

### **Our Country and Our Freedom are Collapsing**

But our country and our freedom are collapsing.

The government our founders built to protect us and our freedom has been fundamentally transformed to serve a different purpose. The limits that protected our freedom have been progressively destroyed, while some Americans argue whether "Black lives matter" or "All lives matter."

During recent years, marches and protests have focused on deaths of black men in which police were involved. But while the protesters demonstrate their anger, their lack of knowledge and their actions actually help the people who divide us by race.

A recent news article told of a black father whose nephew was killed in 2003, apparently in a dispute over money. His son was killed in 2007 by a victim he was attempting to rob, and his cousin was killed in 2009 in a dispute over drugs. <sup>v</sup>

He is now asking other fathers to pay more attention to their kids, ask them questions, and be more involved in their lives, as he participates in a campaign to reduce the violence.

The man is correct, of course, but to solve the many serious problems we face, we must understand the real reasons why we're facing them, and take action to eliminate the causes.

Our country and our freedom are collapsing today because Americans who oppose our founding principles of equal freedom and natural rights are winning their relentless fight to destroy the limited government built to protect our freedom.

## **Subjugation vs. Freedom**

The fight over rights began here in the colonies, before our founders were born. The king claimed a divine right to rule over the colonists, and encouraged them to subjugate African slaves.

Some of his subjects claimed they had a right to rule over their black slaves, whom they considered inferior to them.

But our leading founders wrote that all men are endowed by God with equal rights, including life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness. They meant all humans.

Thomas Jefferson, the primary author of the Declaration of Independence, called slavery a “cruel war against human nature itself, violating its most sacred rights of life and liberty.”<sup>vi</sup>

## **US Constitution: Protection of Freedom**

When people truly live together in freedom, each person’s freedom must be limited by the right of others to be free, but no more than necessary for that purpose.

Our founders built a government to protect our freedom through a strong national defense and the rule of law. They limited its powers to protect citizens from the government.

The Constitution did not create a democracy, but a republic under which our rights can’t be voted away by the majority. It didn’t grant the government powers to solve all our problems, but to protect our freedom and ability to solve our own problems.

## **Slavery: The Flaw in Our Foundation**

The flaw in the US Constitution was that it didn’t abolish slavery. Our leading founders, including some slave owners, proposed abolishing slavery, but they were blocked by others.

They needed to establish a government to ensure national defense, so the leaders compromised, temporarily, they thought.

The Constitution discouraged slavery and allowed Congress to ban the slave trade after twenty years, but didn’t end slavery. The Northwest Ordinance prohibited the spread of slavery.

Congress did outlaw the slave trade, and Jefferson, as third US President, signed the law. But that didn’t end slavery.

## **The Organized Force Against Freedom**

Slavery led to the rise of a powerful and enduring force against freedom when the modern Democratic Party was founded by slave owners during the 1820s to protect slavery.

Their fight to protect slavery was not just a disagreement over a political issue, but direct opposition to our founding principle that all men possess God-given natural rights.

Slave owners claimed that God made the black race unfit for anything except slavery, and gave slave owners a right to use them, as well as a duty to feed, clothe, house, and control them.

In the Dred Scott case, the Democratic Supreme Court Chief Justice wrote that inferiority of the black race was a well-known fact. He ruled that a black man could never be a citizen even if he were not a slave because that would give him the right to speak freely and own a gun, which would make him a free man.

### **From Slavery to Segregation**

Democrats lost their ability to enslave black people in 1865, when Republicans abolished slavery and established citizenship and voting rights for the former slaves through the 13<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup>, and 15<sup>th</sup> Amendments, after the Civil War.

But they quickly regained power, to subjugate black people through segregation, Ku Klux Klan (KKK) terrorism, and gun control laws to keep black men from defending themselves.

### **Progressives and Socialists Join the Segregationists**

In the early 1900s, Democrats aligned with the progressive movement, which rejected the principle of natural rights, and claimed that human rights are determined by government.<sup>vii</sup>

Republican progressives helped them destroy critical limits through income tax and creation of the Federal Reserve.

Then, socialist union bosses working to keep black men from competing with white workers joined with the Democrats.

### **Transformation to Socialism with Segregation**

Democratic leaders made the Great Depression into ten years of misery and fear, ignored the Constitution and destroyed its

limits. They built a huge bureaucracy to control us, gave union bosses special rights over workers, and partially implemented steps in the Communist Manifesto, without claiming to follow it.

Those steps include income taxes that punish high incomes, abolition of property rights, confiscation of property, central control over credit, banking, communications, transportation, factories, and farm lands, and indoctrination of all children in public schools from the earliest possible age. And one more,

*“...In America, where a democratic constitution has already been established, the communists must make the common cause with the party which will turn this constitution against (the middle class)...”* <sup>viii</sup>

Surviving companies began to collude with the bureaucracy Democrats built, to survive and to benefit from federal spending.

World War II, not government programs, ended the Great Depression, while segregation and KKK terrorism continued.

### **Transformation to Socialist Control Over All Americans**

When Republicans finally forced passage of new civil rights laws, Democrats began the transformation currently underway.

Amid assassinations, social upheaval over segregation, and protests over the Vietnam War in the 1960s, Democratic leaders helped pass, then defeated the purpose of civil rights legislation.

They replaced the KKK with Mass Media Propaganda (MMP) as their party’s enforcement arm, and used it to blame segregation and racial discrimination on the Republicans who had freed the slaves and promoted civil rights.

Democrats maintained dominance by regaining control over black voting power, and increased control over all Americans.

### **The Dream and the Reality**

During the struggle to overcome racial segregation in 1963, Reverend Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. (MLK) told us of his dream about freedom, justice, and equal rights. <sup>ix</sup> It was much like the earlier dreams of Frederick Douglass, the former slave who rose to use his skills and intelligence to help abolish slavery.

King dreamed of a day when black and white Americans would share equally in the freedom our great country promises, and judge each other, not by the color of our skin, but by the content of our character.

But Democrats have kept his dream from coming true. Their actions, supported by many good people with good intentions, have kept millions of black Americans poor and segregated on modern urban plantations, living amid crime and violence.

The education of black children in many public schools is so poor that black educator Walter Williams calls it “fraudulent.”<sup>x</sup>

### **The Limits are Broken**

Democrats have broken and destroyed almost all the limits that protected our freedom, with the help of compromising Republicans at times, and illegitimate Supreme Court rulings.

They win elections because they promise to give us anything we want, and make someone else pay. Here’s how it’s working:

### **Democratic Promises vs. Reality**

Millions of seniors are hooked on a bankrupt Social Security System with no fund to pay benefits, and no legal obligation to pay. Every payment depends on tax collections and borrowing.

Millions of Americans are hooked on welfare and food stamps, while poverty rates remain substantially unchanged.

Many college students are hooked on “free” education that’s really not, and left with student loan debt they can’t afford.

Millions of Americans are hooked on “free” health services, which actually increase the cost and diminish their freedom.

Many businesses are hooked on government subsidies and favors that distort free enterprise and create “crony capitalism.”

### **Government Turned Against Its Purpose**

Democrats have turned our government against its purpose,

Mass Media Propaganda and educational indoctrination control us almost as well as Communist propaganda and indoctrination control people in China, Russia, and North Korea.

We are on the brink of losing all our freedom to a financial collapse rivaling the Great Depression, or to war in our streets.

Democrats are dismantling our defense, refuse to defend our borders, and enable Muslim terrorists to obtain nuclear weapons to kill us and our allies, while aliens attack us within our borders.

Our national defense is losing strength as Democrats instead focus government spending on controlling Americans.

US national debt is \$19 trillion, or over \$60,000 for each of us. With many times that in future liabilities, our leaders are stealing from our grandchildren by borrowing even more.

### **Supreme Court's Destruction of Freedom**

The Supreme Court's duty is to apply the law correctly, not to write laws or change them for the supposed general welfare. It is not a political body intended to be balanced. Our freedom and natural rights are not political issues, except to Democrats.

But the US Supreme Court defies the Constitution. Only three of nine Justices have done their duty in recent years, and one of them just died. Two are rogues, and four were appointed only to destroy the Constitution's ability to protect our freedom.

If US senators disregard their duty and approve one more such appointment, we can kiss our freedom goodbye.

### **We Can Still Choose Freedom**

I hope and I believe that we can still survive as a land of freedom where all lives matter without a violent new Revolution or Civil War, if we do it now. If not, we will lose that ability.

But if you think that the issues of slavery, segregation, and equal rights affect only black Americans, you are sadly and dangerously mistaken. They affect all of us.

Almost all the problems facing us today continue to flow from the same fight by some Americans against our founding principles of equal freedom and natural rights granted by God, and the limited government built to protect our freedom. Their fight against freedom started with their support for slavery.

They have disguised their fight against freedom in many ways, and have been supported by many good people with good intentions as their fight to deny human rights has evolved from slavery to segregation to socialism. But we must stop them now.

This is not about just changing your political party. We need to remove the force against freedom from power, demand equal protection, and quit treating human rights as political issues.

If we don't use our votes now to preserve the freedom we were given, we may never have another chance to get it back without a violent revolution or civil war, if that's even possible.

### **What We Must Do to Save Our Freedom**

We need American men and women of all ages and races to understand our principles of freedom, how our founders secured our rights, and how our natural rights are being extinguished.

Thomas Paine wrote in *Common Sense*, "...a long habit of not thinking a thing wrong, gives it a superficial appearance of being right..."<sup>xi</sup>

KCarl Smith, founder of the Frederick Douglass Republicans wrote, "My lack of knowing the true history of both parties (Republican and Democratic) twisted my whole outlook on politics. As a result, others easily persuaded me."<sup>xii</sup>

We need to break the habit of accepting propaganda and educational indoctrination as right.

We need to overcome myths, distortions, and lies about our country, our freedom, and our history that have been drummed into us for more than 50 years. And we must choose freedom.

The time is short, and we need to act now. My attempt to inform and alert my fellow Americans is on the following pages.

Reverend King told us 53 years ago, "Now is the time!"

But today, the time is now or never.
